MALA Updates

Your Upcoming Holiday Closures through November Please make sure that you have reported of all of your Holidays Closures through December. Use the form on the website located here.

- MALA is not closed on Veterans Day (11/11) but many libraries are, and we would like to notify your courier in plenty of time.
- MALA will be closed for Thanksgiving Day and Friday (11/28 & 29). There will be no deliveries on those days.

Reporting Missed Deliveries

PLEASE make sure that you report missed deliveries on our Delivery Services Issues form online, located here. Do not call the MALA office or email specific staff members. The online form is designed so that all staff members have access to it whether in the office or not. By reporting missed deliveries immediately, we are better able to inform Henry and make arrangements for a make-up delivery for your library.

Supplies Requests

MALA has courier bags and plastic totes that libraries can request when they are low on courier shipping materials. Requests should be made via our **Courier Delivery Service Issues/Request Supplies** report form—simply select "Supplies Request" from the drop-down menu under "Courier Issue" and then specify in the comments the type(s) of supplies you need (bags or totes).

Please put in your requests before you run out of supplies—it can take up to two weeks for a supplies request to arrive at your library depending on your number of days of service.

After you put in your request via the form, staff at MALA will prepare your supplies to be sent out. This step usually happens the day of your request, but if it comes in later in the afternoon, it might delay this step a day. From there, a MALA driver will deliver the supplies to the Henry warehouse in Kansas City where they will be sorted. In some instances, those materials will be shipped to another warehouse, sorted again, and only then delivered to requesting library.

If a week has passed since you put in a request and you haven't yet received your supplies, feel free to reach back out to MALA. We can have the warehouses checked to ensure that your items are still en-route.
